

Orange and Black Day Draft Party Agenda

**All you need to plan a one-hour, online Orange & Black Day celebration.
Invite your friends, wherever they are in the world!**

Plan Your Party

Create a Zoom “meeting” and send invitations. *Invite your friends to bring one or two of their favorite Princetoniana items to the party and share their story. A fun twist can also include bringing a Princetoniana item that you have but don’t know its origins. Maybe someone will!*

Get Started

15 minutes before the online party Make yourself a cocktail/mocktail with one of these festive recipes. Check out the digital toolkit.

10 minutes before the online party, open the Zoom link so people can start signing in and saying hello. Greet everyone as they join.

00:00

Formally welcome everyone to a celebration of Orange and Black Day! Offer a toast, and ask if everyone has seen the official video. If not, [play it here](#).

00:05

Trivia starts! Divide people into at least two Zoom rooms to create teams. Each room should have a moderator who will share their screen and present the questions. The moderators will not have the answers, so they can play, too. You could ask them to take 1-minute to pick a team name.

00:15

Check in with moderators on progress. Give them 5 more minutes, if needed.

00:20

Everyone back to the main zoom room for the host to share the trivia answers and announce the winning team.

00:25

Show-and-Tell begins. Host asks people one at a time to share their Princetoniana item and tell the story of it.

00:55

Ask for a show of hands for the most interesting object. Then announce a winner for the oldest object. Offer a rousing cheer or locomotive to each winner.

00:58
