Frequently Asked Questions for Classes

What kinds of events can my class organize?

The possibilities are endless! Here are a few ideas to get you started:

- Receptions or cookouts at an alumnus/a's home
- Picnics or cookouts at a park
- Community service projects or volunteering (followed by a meal or reception)
- Walk or hike with refreshments
- Sporting events, movies, concerts or plays
- Tours of historic sites, museums or art galleries
- Trivia nights or game nights
- Wine tasting or brewery tours
- Crafting or creative workshops
- ... and so much more!

How can I make the event special for my class?

Encourage classmates to wear their jackets or a past Reunions costume. Bring your class banner, take a group photo, and cap it off with a spirited Locomotive for Princeton!

Can my class host more than one party?

Yes! Your class is welcome to host multiple events. Each event should be open to and promoted to all classmates in the area. If space is limited, you may cap registrations.

Can I collaborate with other groups?

Absolutely! We encourage you to work with your local regional association leadership so that the local Tiger community is aware of all Orange & Black Day events in the area, even if your event is only open to your classmates. You may also choose to collaborate with other alumni classes.

How much are the grants?

The Class Affairs Committee is offering grants of \$200 for events with 10 or more alumni attendees.

Note: non-alumni guests do not count toward the minimum alumni attendance.

What can I use the grant for?

Grant funds may be used for:

- Food and beverage expenses
- Décor
- Venue rental fee

What are the grant requirements?

1. A minimum of 10 alumni in attendance (guests are welcome but do not count toward this requirement).
2. Only one grant may be awarded per event, even if multiple classes or groups co-host.
3. Share your photos with us!

How can I share my event photos?

What documentation is required for reimbursement?

1. [Orange & Black Day Event Report Form](#) – including all eligible receipts and event photos (submitted via the form or by [email](#)).
2. [Guest Reimbursement Request Form](#) – completed in full.

What are the deadlines?

- Photos must be submitted by **October 27, 2025** for inclusion in the official Orange & Black Day sizzle video.
- Event reports and grant requests must be received by **November 14, 2025**.
